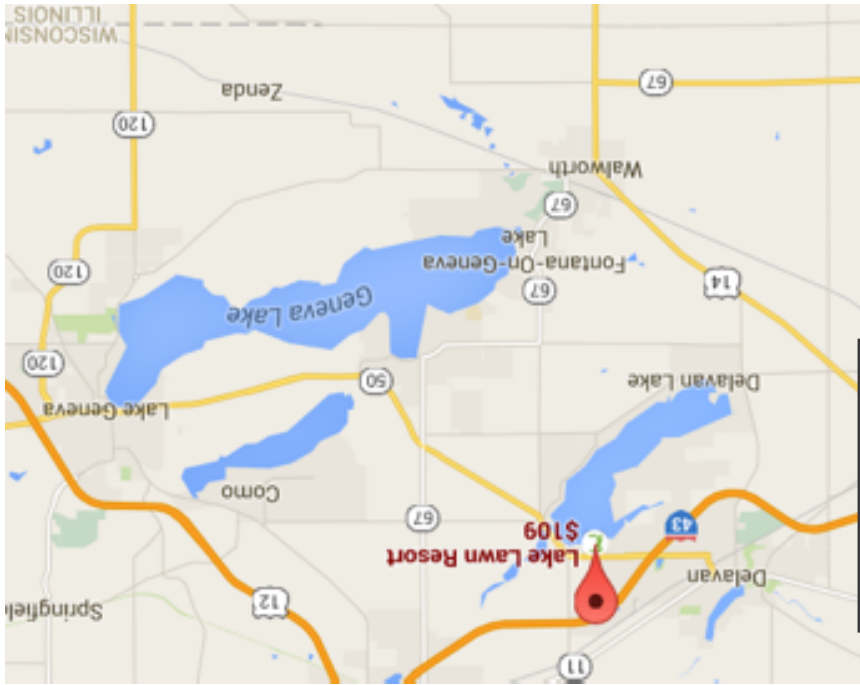


About Louise Austin *Your captain and interplanetary guide*



Louise Austin has been an avid performer and proponent of recorders since she discovered them in 1965. Over the years, she has graduated from proficient player; now she is a certified ARS teacher, dancer, lecturer, and performer with groups including the Genera Consort, the Chicago Baroque Ensemble, Camarata Trio, King Cole Pipers, and many other groups in Illinois and Wisconsin.

She devoted 16 years as an ARS Board member, and served for many years as their music review editor. Her *Playing Music for the Dance* was published by the ARS in 1991 and is available free to members on the ARS web site. She has also served on the *Early Music Now* board and was largely responsible for the series bringing outstanding recorder concerts to Milwaukee. In 1988, during the early years of the series she was instrumental in securing a new recorder group: the Amsterdam Loeki Stardust Quartet.

Louise founded the Oak Park (IL) Recorder School and served for 23 years as director of the Whitewater Early Music Festival, influencing many students, teachers, and professional recorder player from around the country.

Her many accomplishments were recognized, in 2011, when she was presented with the ARS Presidential Special Honor award.

She is currently a private and group instructor of recorder, music director of the Milwaukee Area Recorder Society, and lecturer and teacher of Renaissance dance. She lives in Lake Mills, Wisconsin.
